### SCAM ALERTS (from Which and others)

...**Avoiding and reporting shopping scams.** If an offer is too good to be true, the chances are it is. Watch out for any high-end or in-demand items being flogged at low prices. Here are a few more tips to avoid shopping scams: Browse the website, look out for bad spelling and grammar, as well as the absence of terms and conditions and contact details. Check the URL, if it's not the brand's official website, it could be a scam page. Check how long ago the website was created by using a domain checker such as who.is (a newly created website should raise suspicions). To report a scam ad on Facebook, select the three-dot icon on the right-hand side of the page and press 'report'. Scam websites, like these dodgy phishing websites, can be reported to the National Cyber Security Centre. If you have ordered something and belatedly realise it's dodgy, contact your bank to notify them about the scam immediately. Do not be tempted to give the scammers any further details, even if they claim to be 'refunding' you. If you think you may have been scammed, call your bank immediately using the number on the back of your card, report it to Action Fraud or call the police on 101 if you're in Scotland.
