I have just received the following from the Portfolio Holder for Highways:

"I understand the cones have been stacked up and we will remove them shortly. We are happy to withdraw from 'the street scene' for now as we are still mindful that this is Welsh Government and Public Health Wales guidance. We will keep the door open Beverley for our lead officer and Presteigne Town Council to meet and discuss a way forward if appropriate to do so but at the same time we must be satisfied that businesses can operate in a safe environment for both staff and residents."

It's such a shame that Welsh Government gave everyone 2 days notice to re-open non-essential shops and Powys rushed into what they thought was a good idea. They really did think they were helping but as always Presteigne had everything under control with volunteers. I, along with the Town Council, will work with the officer assigned to Presteigne in the next week or so to see if there are some improvements that can be made.

I appreciate many people were upset about the situation and are quite entitled to have a good moan on social media, to me etc, but I must just say I am embarrassed by the one or two people that were so hostile to some of the Council Highways staff that the Police had to be called. Perhaps you could identify yourself personally to the staff members and apologise. I can only assume they were having a bad day!

Thank you to everyone who has contacted me with various suggestions I shall take them forward and we can discuss in due course.

Please continue to support our local shops (now you can nip in after parking on the high street) and remember to stay safe. We have a wonderful community spirit and the volunteers have been fantastic as have most people. So let's move forward.
