Update from Norton Community Trust: The plans to adapt the Norton church building into a community hub continue, if a bit slower than we had hoped. The church has now officially been declared redundant - in future it can be used for occasional religious services, including public worship, baptisms, funerals, and marriage blessings. Powys County Council have responded to the planning applications and we're responding to their request for a range of additional information. We knew the planning process would be challenging and we don't expect a final decision before the autumn. We have also been exploring options for our legal status, and we are looking at the possibility of coming under the umbrella of the Presteigne and Norton Community Trust whose main object seems to be a good fit for the Adaption project. Discussions are underway with the Council on this. And the Norton calendar photo competition is still alive – we have the chance to capture the best of Norton across all four seasons, aiming to judge the photo entries at the Norton Show in summer 2021 and have a calendar for 2022 which will make us all proud. Dear all - Confirmation from Welsh Government and Powys Council: Summer term ends a week later on Friday 24th July : Holiday Club Monday 27th July to Tuesday 1st September; Autumn term will start Wednesday 2nd September; Half term (Autumn) is two weeks long and will start on Monday 19th October.

...from the Welsh Government. Playgrounds and community centres will reopen in Wales from 20 July. First Minister Mark Drakeford said also that cinemas, museums and galleries would to be able to open "in the third week of this cycle", which is around 27 July. Earlier he said campsites would reopen on 25 July "provided we make a success of self-contained accommodation". He also said house viewings with owners present would be possible from 27 July. Confirmation that pubs, restaurants and cafes can resume trading outdoors from Monday 13 July is expected today at the Welsh Government's daily coronavirus briefing. Playgrounds have been closed since the start of lockdown and the Welsh Government said it was allowing them to reopen ahead of the summer holidays.

...from Powys Recycles. Please remember to sort your waste before arriving at the HWRCs. This helps keep your visit short and within the current 10-minutes allowed on site. Bags of mixed waste (recyclable and non-recyclable material) are not allowed into the residual waste skips. You will be asked to take your waste home and return once it has been sorted.
