...from the Welsh Government. People in Wales <u>must wear face masks in shops and other</u> <u>indoor public spaces from Monday</u>, the first minister has announced. Mark Drakeford said the change came as 20 people in every 100,000 in Wales now had coronavirus. Indoor meetings of more than six from an extended household will be illegal from Monday. The rule will <u>not</u> apply to children under 11, AND up to 30 people from different homes <u>can still meet outside</u>.

...from Maggie: Now we have it now we don't! PCC Climate Emergency declaration motion succeeded ... then failed! PCC recently declared a Climate Emergency by a very tight margin (the casting vote in favour was our PCC Councillor Bev Baynham). Subsequently it seems that this vote was miscounted and so the motion has fallen. The motion will be put before the county councillors again at the full council's September meeting. Since the beginning of the #COVID19 pandemic, face-to-face courses for the National Driver Offender Re-training Scheme have been suspended, and we won't be holding these for the foreseeable future. We've introduced the option of completing your course online by accessing our digital classroom, but to do this we need <u>you to get in touch with us</u> to let us know that's an option you'd like to take up, and to make the arrangements. Parents are also being reminded to make sure that they have provided their child's school with up-to-date emergency contact details.
