The Welsh Government have announced that we have to stop serving alcohol at 10pm with a drinking up time of 20mins. We will now be operating table service only which means no one can stand at the bar to order a drink. A member of staff will take your order and serve your drink to the table. Please be patient with our staff. We will be asking you to wear a face mask when moving round the building.... Toilet, smoking. The mask can be taken off when you are seated at your table. We already have a trace and trace system in place this is to keep you and us safe so please continue to do this. This is now Law. We also encourage you to use the NHS Covid-19 App - our QR code is displayed around the building. We are not allowed to book tables of more than 6, tables should be people who are in the same or extended households. Lastly but most importantly we would like to thank you all for your continued support in these difficult times.

...from Powys Teaching Health Board ref Flu vaccination for 50-64 year olds. This year the NHS in Wales will be extending the offer of flu vaccination to those aged 50-64 years of age. Additional vaccine supplies have been ordered for this purpose by the UK Government, but please note that these will not start to arrive in Powys from central stores until late November. Please also be aware that the vaccines will be supplied on a phased basis. What this means is that vaccine is not yet available and, when it is available, it is likely to be administered over a period of weeks and on an age-based approach, i.e. starting with the oldest age groups first. Exact details of how people aged 50-64yrs will be invited for vaccination and where vaccination will take place will be made available nearer the time, but in the meantime, please DO NOT contact your GP for a flu vaccine if you are in this age group as vaccine is not available. This does not apply if you are already eligible for flu vaccination as someone who is in a pre-existing at risk category, and you will be contacted by your GP surgery to arrange vaccination as per usual. More information will be released by Powys Teaching Health Board via social media, the Health Board website, and your GP website about vaccination for 50-64yr olds in the next few weeks as arrangements are confirmed.
