...about vaccinations if you're registered with Knighton's Wylcwm Street Surgery. A letter sent to over 80s inviting them to go to Newtown for their vaccination gave no contact details to allow for cancellations. This is the tel.no: 03456 027053. Knighton patients are being directed to Newtown because Wylcwm Street Surgery, although NHS, is privately operated. As the practice at Presteigne is part of the NHS Trust, their patients will be seen at Knighton Hospital. While Wylcwm Street awaits its 'licence'. people are encouraged to take up the Newtown offer if possible and help ease the pressure at Knighton once they are able to vaccinate. Please pass this information on to anybody who might be worried or is not on Facebook, thank you

...from Powys Teaching Health Board ref duplicated vaccine appointment letters - 'It may help for me to outline the circumstances of the Presteigne vaccination scheme. A couple of weeks ago all names of the eligible population were loaded onto the NHS Wales system for automated letters. It takes a couple of weeks lead in time for the letters to be generated etc. It was after this that the possibility of an earlier, local scheme could be put in place. The GP practice were keen to proceed and therefore patients were called. Some patients came this week just gone and some will come next week. I will double check that the practice staff have explained to patients to ignore the letter inviting them to Builth and ensure a double check at the Builth Vaccine Centre, as because they have had their first vaccine under the local scheme there is an intention that the second dose will also be delivered locally. We have aimed to get this huge endeavour up and running swiftly and in doing so we realise there will be some bumps in the road, which we hope will be smoothed out shortly. Our aim is to ensure all eligible people get access to their vaccine as swiftly as possible.'

Report to <u>abuse@bt.com</u> and also to report@phishing.gov.uk, then delete. *[ed. these came through today on my gmail account and I know others have got them as well].*

...from Leigh at Presteigne Dark Skies. The Presteigne Dark Skies Masterplan continues to gain traction. PCC is undertaking a survey of the current street-lighting in Presteigne and Norton, with the results being presented to the Town Council on the 20th January. More light pollution measurements will also be taken in January using a Sky Quality meter (following Covid 19 guidelines). This is so that a baseline can be confirmed before changes are made to the street-lighting. In February 2021 a trial of dark skies compliant lighting is scheduled to take place in Presteigne. This will compare street-lights produced by different manufacturers, and will be in the vicinity of the Judge's Lodging. It will be an opportunity for residents to compare the different types of street-lights and their effect on the night time experience in Presteigne.

...from Powys CC. Re-opening day centres is still not possible under current Covid-19 restrictions in Powys, the council has decided. Day centres for the elderly and for people with learning disabilities have been closed since March due to the pandemic. Now, Powys County Council is looking to extend the temporary closure of these facilities until August, 2021 (subject to the Portfolio Holder's final approval on January 14). During this time, social care staff will discuss with citizens how best to support their needs. The majority of individuals who attend day services do so in order to meet up with and socialise with others while receiving care during the day. It is not currently possible to provide such a service due to the requirements of guidance to mitigate the impact of the pandemic. During the pandemic, people who were attending the day centres have either been supported in different ways (e.g. living with the support of carers, either full or part time, or family support) or have chosen to not receive alternative support. Staff, who normally work in day services have been redeployed to work in business-critical areas such as domiciliary care, whilst others have become part of the Council's Track and Trace team.

...from Tim Craddock. " A PACDG newsletter before Christmas covered the issue of the very poor state of the road which leads from Presteigne via Stocken Farm to the top of Stonewall Hill. As a result of the piece in the Newsletter, a number of residents subsequently wrote to the Town Council, and the issue was discussed at a Council meeting before Christmas. Since the road is a Herefordshire road, the question is how to put pressure on Herefordshire County Council, and their contractors, Balfour Beatty, to reassess the priority of the road for repair. Fay Jones, our Westminster MP, is also taking the issue up and has been in touch with Balfour Beatty. Balfour Beatty have now replied both to Fay Jones MP and to the Town Council. The reply says that the road is still not being moved up their list of priorities for repair. Fay Jones will approach them again; and the Town Council will discuss Balfour Beatty's response at their meeting on 20 January. It is ironic that the road in question is now being used as one of the main diversionary routes this week while the Presteigne - Knighton B road has works on it. There has been an increase in traffic on it. It remains in a very poor state, is dangerous to use, and several residents' cars have been damaged on the road. Please be aware of this if using the road in coming days. Any residents who have points to make about the road should do so before the TC meeting on 20 January".
