We will have marshals to manage pedestrians and traffic. We need to ensure that there are sufficient marshals to control traffic and keep pedestrians safe, particularly regarding social distancing. #### **COVID**

...from Powys THB. [This week] sees the launch of COVID vaccinations at your local GP practice in Powys. All 16 GP practices in Powys will being vaccinating people this week, adding to the county's already successful Mass Vaccination Centres and bringing the number of places you can receive the vaccine in Powys to 19. With the addition of GP vaccinations, Powys is currently aiming to deliver around 7,000 vaccines per week and it is expected that this capacity will increase as vaccine supply increases in the coming weeks. Every person over the age of 80 should now have received a letter giving them a vaccination appointment. Anyone who has not received a letter can let us know by registering at <a href="https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination/over-80-in-powys-and-not-received-an-invitation-to-vaccination/">https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination/over-80-in-powys-and-not-received-an-invitation-to-vaccination/</a>. In order to reduce the risk of people being given duplicate appointments and vaccine being potentially wasted, GP Practices are working to a list of patients supplied by the health board and are phoning patients to invite them for vaccination. Please do NOT call your GP directly for COVID vaccination at this time as they need their telephone capacity to make the outgoing calls to make the appointments.

...are you aged 70-74 and able to take up a short-notice Welsh vaccination appointment at Builth Wells or Newtown? If so please fill out the form on the PTHB website <a href="https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination/age-70-to-74/are-you-able-to-attend-a-mass-vaccination-centre-appointment-at-short-notice/">https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination/age-70-to-74/are-you-able-to-attend-a-mass-vaccination-centre-appointment-at-short-notice/</a>. We have guaranteed supplies of good quantities of the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine, but we can only deliver this from our Mass Vaccination Centres. But attending our Mass Vaccination Centres is not an option for everyone - and also some people may not be able to attend at short notice (e.g. due to travel disruption, sickness, or other life events). This does mean that we can **sometimes** offer an appointment at short notice. (n.b. this does not apply to the 75-80 age group, who will be receiving an appointment shortly from their GP). ...from Powys THB. If a contact tracer calls, it's likely to be someone local to you. It's important that you speak to them and self-isolate immediately if you're asked to, so we can help stop the spread of the virus. ...[ed.] if you're unable to take up your Welsh vaccination appointment, or have to cancel for any reason, or have received a duplicate appointment(!), please let Powys THB know asap so the vaccination slot can be allocated to someone else to avoid vaccine waste. ...from Zoe & the King's College research teams. You can help fight COVID-19 by aiding research. It's amazingly easy to do. Join 4,558,822 members of the UK public supporting the NHS and scientists in the UK. Download the (FREE) Zoe app now from either the Apple of Google App Stores and report daily on your health, any Covid symptoms, vaccinations etc.. Together we can get out of lockdown safely and beat the disease. The COVID Symptom Study app has been developed by health science company ZOE. It is endorsed by the governments, NHS and Public Health of the UK and all three devolved nations. Data collected is shared with and analysed by King's College London & ZOE research teams.

...from Anna, our CSPO from our Neighbourhood Policing Team about modern slavery in our area. After Christmas, people are under greater financial pressure and are at more risk of being economically vulnerable. This might lead them to be exploited in the labour market, being paid less than the minimum wage or finding work in sub-standard conditions. *Modern* Day Slavery is something we have seen and had reported within our local communities. Examples include: forced labour on farms, construction, shops and within the beauty industry. Modern Day Slavery isn't something only experienced by adults, but also children of all ages. It is therefore essential we all understand what it is and how to recognise. Modern slavery is an umbrella term for all forms of slavery, human trafficking and exploitation. It is a crime that affects some of the most vulnerable in society. It is often hidden from view and many victims also do not self-identify, which means that quantifying the number of victims is challenging. Labour exploitation is a form of modern slavery and is covered by the Modern Slavery Act in the UK. Victims of labour exploitation are forced to work for nothing, low wages or a wage that is kept by their "owner". Victims can be any age, gender and race, but more often than not they are male. What are the signs? Victims may... be unable to choose when or where they work...Work long hours over long periods... Not interact with work colleagues... Be forced to work under certain conditions... Not know their home or work address... Live in poor or substandard accommodation... Have no choice where they live or who with... Be unable to communicate or move freely... Not be in possession of their passport, bank card or ID... Have no access to medical care... Have injuries that appear old, untreated or that they can't explain... Wear the same clothes each day... Receive little or no payment for their work... Have no access to their money.
