- ...from Arrowfield Vets. Lambing season is upon us here at AVP. With heavily pregnant ewes and young lambs out in the fields, this is a critical time in the farming year. Let's give our farmers one less thing to worry about by KEEPING DOGS ON LEADS at all times around livestock and following the footpaths. Many people don't realise Sheep worrying is a crime, and it is not worth the risk to the sheep or your dog.
- ...from the Powys Waste Enforcement Officer. If the cardboard recycling skips at the Bring Site are full please take your cardboard back home DO NOT leave it on the ground by the skips. Apart from it being unsightly and likely to blow around littering our town, this is FLYTIPPING and, if it is traced back to you, you WILL be fined a substantial amount. Note that cameras are now being utilised at the Bring Site to help identify people dumping contaminating rubbish in the recycling skips or on the ground you have been warned!

...(PTHB) the latest edition of our weekly newsletter about COVID-19 vaccination in Powys is now available to download or read online: https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination-newsletter/

- ...(PTHB) our reserve list is closed for this week. Thanks for your interest. As the Pfizer/ BioNTech vaccine is now only available for second dose vaccinations we do not currently need the same type of reserve list as we did earlier this month. Instead, where cancellations do occur we are calling on people who'd not yet received their invitation or who had to miss a previous appointment (e.g. due to travel disruption) as well as people who've already filled in this week's reserve list before it closed. We therefore don't currently expect to reopen our reserve list for the time being. https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination/age-65-to-69/are-you-able-to-attend-a-mass-vaccination-centre-appointment-at-short-notice/
- ...(PTHB) on eligibility for COVID-19 vaccination for unpaid carers. We expect to receive more information next week (week beginning 1 March) about how eligible unpaid carers can request vaccination https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination/unpaid-carers/
- ...(PTHB) on vaccination for those with underlying health conditions. In order to vaccinate as many people as possible, as quickly as possible, those aged 16-65 with underlying health conditions are being divided into two groups:- Those aged 16-49 will be vaccinated at their GP practice Those aged 50-65 will be vaccinated at one of the three Mass Vaccination Centres in Powys. Please note, it is not possible to 'switch' locations between GP/MVC. PLEASE DO NOT phone to make an appointment; we have your details and will be inviting you for vaccination as soon as we are able. Thank you for helping us to make the system as effective as possible to protect the community. - ...(PTHB) in line with national guidance we want to offer you your second dose around 11 weeks after your first dose. If you received your first dose vaccination on or before 26 December and have not yet received your invitation for your second dose then please get in touch. More information about second dose appointments, including a Priority Access Form if you received your first dose on or before 26 December, is available from our website: https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination/second-dose-appointments/
- ...Herefordshire CC. With eligible groups changing, check if you meet the current criteria to book your vaccination online. Even if you have not had a GP letter you could be eligible to book. To find out more: http://orlo.uk/VQ2J2
- ...from PNCS Community Transport about transport for COVID vaccinations. If anyone in Presteigne, Norton or the surrounding area is having difficulty travelling to a COVID vaccination appointment, PNCS is pleased to be able to offer transport, both to PNCS members and non-

members alike. **Due to the extraordinary situation, PNCS** is offering this service free of charge. Anyone who needs transport to a vaccination appointment should contact the PNCS office by telephone on 01544 267961, or by email on transport.pncs@gmail.com .(Please note: Whilst we will do our best to accommodate everyone, we do only have a limited number of drivers available. If you can use your own transport to attend an appointment, please do that so we can use the available drivers to support those who really need help.)

SPAM / SCAM WARNINGS

...a warning from DVLA about online companies called Licence Safe, Licence Secure, Driving Licence Assistance, Electronic Check Ltd or 'DL Renewal Online' - these are all scam operations which have their own website but also manage to pick up business via the DVLA site. If you want to renew your licence, inform DVLA of a change of address or insure your licence (why would you do that?!), and even if you think you are in touch with DVLA, you may be directed to these people and asked to pay a subscription of £97 or more; they offer to do everything for you: but this is unlikely. They might be just within the law (!) but there is a warning on the DVLA site and much criticism on uk.trustpilot.com
