From 1 April 2021, all requests for non-emergency hospital transport should be directed to the Welsh Ambulance Service NHS Trust hub above with the following exceptions:

- \* If a patient's appointment is in Hereford County Hospital and for any service other than radiotherapy they should call the Powys Call Centre (01686 613200)
- \* If the appointment is for Radiotherapy at Hereford County they contact Welsh Ambulance Service on 0300 123 23
- \* If a patient's appointment is at the Robert Jones and Agnes Hunt Hospital, Oswestry then they will call Falck on 03300 535695
