- ...from Powys THB. We have appointments available for first dose Pfizer/BioNTech at Newtown Mass Vaccination Centre on the morning of 3 June. Fill in our Priority Access Form if you can answer "yes" to all three questions: I am 18+...I am registered with a Powys GP...I have not had my first dose. If you have previously filled in our Priority Access Form there is no need to do it again. But, if you filled it in more than a week ago then we HAVE been trying to contact you (you may wish to complete it again in case your contact details were not correct first time). https://pthb.nhs.wales/find/priority-access

Scam Texts: You ŷcan also report suspicious texts by forwarding the original message to 7726, which spells SPAM on your keypad. The law requires all children travelling in the front or rear seat of any car, van or goods vehicle must use the correct child car seat until they are either 135 cm in height or 12 years old (which ever they reach first). After this they must use an adult seatbelt. There are very few exceptions. It is the driver's responsibility to ensure that children under the age of 14 years are restrained correctly in accordance with the law. There are many different types of child car seat available so take your time when choosing. Visit shops and look around on websites to get a good idea of what seats are available and which ones are likely to be the most suitable for your child and your car.
