...from the Town Council. Help needed - were you on Went's Meadow over the weekend? Did you see anyone misusing and damaging the outdoor hand gel dispenser sited at the corner of the Scout Hut car park. The dispenser has been repeatedly rocked to and fro and snapped off at the base at some point over the last two days causing considerable damage. This incident has been reported to Dyfed Powys police who are investigating. Please, if you saw anything do contact the police on 101 quoting incident number DP-20210614-061. Further investigation has found additional damage - to a dispenser in the toilet block, part of the skateboard area fence and large amounts of broken glass in the old Barn.

At the last Council meeting, Presteigne and Norton Town Council agreed to trial the fitting of infra-red motion sensors to the 'Dark Skies' street-lighting in Presteigne High Street. If this trial is successful it will be a UK first. The lights will sense when someone is near them and come up to full power. Intelligent lighting!

...Presentation and Q&A to explain the Climate & Ecological Emergency Bill. The Climate & Ecological Emergency Bill alliance has been running a campaign to get the UK government to pass the Climate and Ecological Emergency Bill (CE Bill) in the Houses of Parliament. The CEE Bill would oblige the UK government to take the strong, decisive action required to match parliament's 2019 declaration of a climate emergency. Across the UK, local, town and county councils have been passing motions expressing support for the CEE Bill, to help persuade their MP to vote in favour. Many people have asked for more information about what is contained in the bill and to address this, PACE has organised a presentation and Q&A specifically for residents of Powys <u>at 7:30pm</u>, <u>Tuesday June 15th</u>, to help give a better sense of what the Bill contains. ...from Herefordshire Council. If you're aged 25 or over, or if you turn 25 before 1 July 2021, you can now book your COVID-19 vaccine <u>http://orlo.uk/nhs_ngFX</u>

...from Powys THB. If you received your first dose in Powys on or before 2 April and haven't received your invitation for a second dose then please get in touch so that we can fast-track you to an appointment. <u>https://pthb.nhs.wales/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination/second-dose-appointments/second-dose-priority-access-form/</u>

...from Powys THB. Following confirmation of cases of the new Delta variant in the county, health chiefs are renewing their call for residents to "get tested" if they have symptoms and participate in vaccination. "Throughout June, PCR tests for people with COVID-19 symptoms continue to be available from our testing sites in Brecon, Builth Wells, Machynlleth, Newtown, Welshpool and Ystradgynlais. You can also order these tests by post. "We have also increased the number of locations where you can drop in to collect Lateral Flow Devices for regular tests if you don't have symptoms. These are available for anyone who cannot work from home, for volunteers, and for unpaid carers. Lateral flow devices can be collected from Brecon, Builth Wells, Crickhowell, Hay-on-Wye, Knighton, Llandrindod Wells, Llanidloes, Machynlleth, Newtown and Ystradgynlais. You can also order lateral flow devices by post. "And, throughout June we have a rapid walk-in testing centre in Newtown for people who do not have symptoms. This is open to everyone. It is located at the Park Street Day Centre in Newtown and is open seven days a week from 10am to 6pm." If you have COVID-19 symptoms then you should follow the latest guidance on self-isolation. People with confirmed COVID-19 are also encouraged to take part in contact tracing to help stop the spread. More information about testing in Powys is available from https://pthb.nhs.wales/find/ttp

...from Which Scam Alert. Census 2021 phishing. Scammers are continuing to tell people through fake texts that their Census submission either hasn't been received or that information is missing, and because of this they risk being fined $\pounds1,000$. It essentially tries to panic you into proving you've already taken part in order to extract your personal information and target you with further scams. Here's how to deal with the fake messages.
