- ...The BBC will end its licence fee grace period for over-75s on 31 July, with 260,000 pensioners still yet to pay. The right to a free TV licence for that age group ended last August for all except those in receipt of the pension credit benefit. But in February, the BBC announced a transition period due to the pandemic.

Please check your own home and family members' homes for medical equipment that is no longer needed to help others in need. Millions of £s worth of equipment is currently on loan in the community. - ...from Powys CC. Care workers working in the independent sector should have received information from their employers by now on how to apply for the Welsh Government's £735 Covid-19 payment. The WG announced earlier this year that they would be paying NHS and care workers a special payment of £735 to recognise their work during the pandemic. The figure was chosen to allow the staff to 'take home' £500 after tax and NI deductions. In Powys, the scheme is being managed on behalf of the government by the county council all claim forms need to be received by the council for processing by September 30th of this year.

...a reminder from Waste Not UK. Both Asda and Tesco now offer plastic bag and film recycling in store. The more we recycle, the less pollution there is. If you go to these supermarkets, or know someone else who does, please do your bit and recycle these plastics - the quantity still going to landfill is frightening!
