...Cemetery Dedication - PRESS RELEASE - on Wednesday 18th August Presteigne and Norton Town Council held a short ceremony of dedication at the new extension to Presteigne Cemetery. Town Mayor, Cllr. Fiona Preece spoke on the history of the work and thanked those involved for their efforts in bringing the project to fruition. As long ago as 2014 the Town Council had become aware that the existing cemetery was reaching capacity and had commenced discussions with the County Council on how to secure ground to provide for local burials into the future. The Town Council then bought the initial area in 2017, selling it on to the County Council in due course and also holding discussions with another adjacent landowner on more land to enable a car park which PCC agreed to buy with a financial contribution from the Town Council. A much needed new facility for the Cemetery was then possible. Work was finally completed in May 2021. County Councillor for Presteigne Ward, Cllr. Beverley Baynham (also Portfolio Holder for Corporate Governance and Regulatory Services which is responsible for cemeteries in the County) spoke on the benefits of collaborative working and the success of the partnership of Town and County Councils. She thanked all involved in carrying out the project at County and Town Council level. Rev. Steve Hollinghurst then spoke a few words of formal dedication for the new area.

COVID

...from Powys THB. Yesterday (1 September 2021), the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI) advised that a third COVID-19 vaccine primary dose be offered to individuals, aged 12 years and over, who were severely immunosuppressed at the time of either, or both, of their first two vaccine doses. This is because some individuals who are severely immunosuppressed due to underlying health conditions or certain medical treatments may not produce a full immune response to COVID-19 vaccination. These individuals need additional protection and I welcome this advice. The JCVI advice details the groups who will be eligible and our NHS in Wales will work quickly to identify eligible individuals who will be contacted by their Health Boards. The decision on the timing of the third dose will be important for some patients, and will be determined by their specialist clinicians. Their appointment will be at an appropriate time during their treatment plan. There is no need for patients to contact their health board or clinicians to check eligibility. Work will begin immediately to identify and plan for patients to be vaccinated and communications from Health Boards will follow as soon as practicable. We are working with specialist clinicians to identify and contact individuals who are eligible for a third dose under the latest guidance. Please do not contact your health board or GP practice about third doses.
