...from Dyfed-Powys Police Inspector Adam Ellis about the Hereford St one-way system: We are aware that there are a number of reports that motorists are ignoring the No Entry signs leading into Hereford Street, Presteigne. We are keen to emphasise that any motorists found ignoring the "No Entry" signs could find themselves liable to a fixed penalty notice or prosecution. We hope that by working with the local community, highlighting the changes and addressing any concerns we can prevent re-occurrences and avoid enforcement, thank you.

Powys residents will get through around 15,000 pumpkins this Halloween, with the potential for around 75 tonnes of extra food waste in the process. Do one less scary thing this year and make the most of your pumpkin. There are many delicious recipes for using the scooped out insides at www.lovefoodhatewaste.com Any leftover peel (and the shell once you've finished scaring everyone with it) can then simply be recycled in your weekly household food waste collection service. Don't worry if your lantern is massive – leaving it alongside the caddy is fine. Not only will this stop food waste going into landfill, it can create green energy and produce an environmentally-sustainable fertiliser to help Welsh farmers grow more food. For every ten tonnes of food waste we recycle, we help to create enough green electricity to power the average household for a year. ...from Which. Pension scams on the rise. Fraudsters are exploiting pension reforms and the uncertainty created by the pandemic to trick people out of their life savings. Read more https://orlo.uk/sc93k. Plus...Have you had a WhatsApp message out of the blue, on a brand new number, and supposedly from your child? It's probably a scam. We've had reports of people in our area receiving these messages from scammers who tell you that they're your child, and that they have a new phone number. Then they'll strike up a conversation before asking for money from you which they'll give a variety of different reasons for – from fixing their phone, to paying for a train or taxi fare, or even paying back a loan. Don't lose out, and don't pay. Always make sure you double check that the person you're talking to genuinely is who they say they are. Please help us prevent these types of scams by sharing this message with people who may not see it here.
