Powys businesses have been warned to be on their guard for scammers impersonating council officers and charging for advice. ...Callers have been contacting some Powys residents, claiming they are from the council and that they owe money on their Council Tax. Our staff will never call you and demand that you make an immediate payment over the phone. If you receive a cold call: Don't give out any of your personal details • Don't give out any of your bank details • Don't let on that you live alone. Or call 0300 123 2040, Mon - Frid ...Fake Primark gift card emails. Phishing emails promising Primark gift card 'rewards' have been circulating. They work by claiming that you need to 'activate the delivery' in order to receive the reward and even attempt to deceive you by including 'your account information'. Due to Welsh Government rules, a valid "**NHS COVID Pass**" may be necessary for films <u>from 15th November</u>. Buying your ticket online is the best way to guarantee yourself a seat. We have at least 30 seats available for advance purchase for each film. It is also hugely helpful if those with tickets (online and season) can arrive as early as possible to claim their seats so that we can assess availability of door tickets, which will be more limited The lift at the Assembly Rooms is currently unusable and there is no disabled access to the upper floor. ...the Police & Crime Commissioner for the Dyfed-Powys area Dafydd Llywelyn, has launched a public consultation on policing priorities and police funding, giving the public the opportunity to influence vital policing decisions. The Commissioner's policing priorities for 2021-2025 are set out in his (Draft) Police and Crime Plan which commits to ensuring victims are at the heart of every decision, with a specific focus on understanding victims' views, taking trauma-informed approaches and looking at community-based solutions. Residents and businesses across Dyfed-Powys will have until 30 November 2021 to have their final say on the Police and Crime Commissioner's draft Police and Crime Plan, as well as the police precept level for next financial year.
