Some items of particular interest: Council Surgeries at the Farmer's Market will resume in December with Cllrs. Wilding & Ruby - Footpath stile kits are to be delivered to a number of landowners in the area covered by the walks on the TC website - the Welsh Water Community Fund has awarded £500 to the Town Council for the Dark Skies Project - the street lighting upgrade programme is hoped to start before the end of the year. **The next full Council meeting** is on Wednesday 15th December (online and in The Assembly Rooms). Meeting papers available 9th December. **A warm welcome to our new Councillor, Kate Van Den Ende,** co-opted at the November meeting and whose first meeting will be on 15th December. Kate fills the vacancy created after the resignation of Lisa Veary.
