Good news on local recycling facilities - in addition to facilities at Kington Co-Op, the Knighton Co-Op store also now has recycling bins for crisp packets, plastic film (clean soft plastics), batteries, and Britax water filters, by the check-out desks. A reminder - you can recycle batteries at SPAR Presteigne, crisp packets at No.46 Wine Bar (for Guide Dogs), and tetrapak-type drink cartons and coffee cups at the bypass Bring Site.

SCAM ALERT

- ...Fake delivery texts link to cloned Post Office website. Scammers are targeting the Post Office in a new fake text scam that's one of the most convincing we've seen. The texts state that a parcel delivery has failed and ask recipients to click the link to 'book a new date' or 'reschedule a delivery' via two sites that have nothing to do with the Post Office. This is a sophisticated scam that you need to be aware of. Here's what to watch out for.
- ...'Hi Mum, my other phone crashed. But this is my temporary number'. If you receive a WhatsApp from an unknown number with someone claiming to be a family member, be very careful! Help us spread the word. whi.ch/WhatsAppScammers
- ... Fake texts claiming to be from NatWest stating that 'a new device has been registered' with your account are circulating, aiming to send recipients through to a website that has nothing to do with the bank. Note the number, copy the message & text to 7726, then delete!

COVID & FLU

- ...from Herefordshire CC. Wondering which COVID-19 test you should use? If you DON'T have symptoms, take lateral flow tests regularly. If you DO have symptoms, take a PCR test. For more info: https://orlo.uk/Rzfbf
- ...from Powys CC. 1 in 3 people with Covid-19 do not have symptoms. Protect your friends and family by testing regularly collect LFT test kits from your pharmacy, local library, and the East Radnor Freedom Leisure Centre.
