Glass bottles of any colour like wine, beer, spirits and soft drinks can be recycled at home along with jars, such as sauces, jam and baby food. However! some glass is NOT accepted in our kerbside collections, e.g. glass cookware (like pyrex), microwave plates, drinking glasses and light bulbs, mirrors - this is because some types of glass do not melt at the same temperature and need to be recycled separately. Check with your local HWRC for advice on recycling this sort of glass.
