...from Presteigne & Norton Community Support. PLEASE HELP!! We desperately need more volunteer drivers to be able to continue our service to the community. Mileage payments are made so you're not out of pocket. If you can spare any time and are able to help. please call in to see Sharon at the PNCS High Street office or call 01544 267961. Thank you! ...from Richard. Dog walkers in Norton please note, Ewes and lambs now in the fields at Norton Mill and likely to be both sides of the village in the coming days. Please take care whilst out walking, dogs must be kept on a lead where livestock are present. Thank you. ...from Beth at Knit and Natter (at the Methodist Church) - Ukraine. We have long been sending our knitting to International Aid Trust who have people working in Ukraine and Moldova, Before I committed, I wanted assurances that they could get the goods through to where it was needed. They responded by saying their team has stayed on in Ukraine, dispensing food medical items and toiletries. They have a truck ready to go there and permission to enter the country. They have already sent a truck to Moldova to distribute to refugees there and the paperwork is complete for them to take the aid to Romania (also to help refugees). We are coordinating a response. There will be collection points at the side door of our Methodist church and inside St Andrews. A full list of what they urgently need is on our notice board and the boxes. Please note they have asked that the food has at least 1 year's sell by date. Even if hostilities end soon, this will be a long term problem for the refugees and their host countries. Your help will be greatly appreciated! In light of this news, our next Lent Lunch (on 2nd April) will give the donations to the Ukraine appeal to help with transport costs.

COUNCIL NEWS

...Community Ultra-fast Broadband Project, Presteigne & Norton: Every household and business should now have received letters about the project. We need 30% take-up for the project to move to the next stage - but as of this morning we have just over half the number of registrations needed. Please, if you haven't done so, can you register asap. It only takes a few minutes online or you can do so by filling in the form you should have received and returning it. There is NO COMMITMENT at this stage but by registering you will be helping the project to go ahead. Local elections take place this year on the 5th May for both Town Council & County Council. For the County Council election, following a review, the Wales Boundary Commission decided to remove Norton from the Presteigne Ward. Norton will now be served by a new Councillor who will cover Llangunllo, Whitton, Norton, Dolau and all the rural areas in between. I have taken the decision to stand again as CC for the Presteigne Ward and hope you may be able to support me in the upcoming election. COVID & FLU

...Rules are easing in Wales. You now no longer have to wear a mask by law in many public places indoors, BUT they are still legally required in shops, on buses/trains, in hairdressers & salons, and in health & social care settings, unless you are exempt.
