SCAM ALERT

...from Which. Amazon scam. We've seen examples of fake Amazon emails many times, but a new example claiming your account has been 'locked' could look genuine enough to deceive you if you don't take a moment to assess it. Its layout is slick – the branding looks genuine and the message is clear: act now or all your 'pending orders' will be cancelled. It even adds a sense of panic by claiming that 'the billing information you provided did not match the information on file' with the card issuer. Report emails on report@phishing.gov.uk then delete!

... from Joanne. Horses on the road! I have just returned from riding my horse, mainly off road and using the abundance of bridleways. However, we do have to do some road work to get to the bridleways. While riding through Norton on the main B4355 I had to ask numerous vehicles to slow down when passing, most of them were happy to comply but not all. The new guidance clearly states that passing speeds should be less than 10 miles an hour at a minimum distance of 2M, please be mindful that this applies in both directions. Drivers need to understand that horses do not always react as expected and if you are in an unusual or exceptionally loud vehicle then please pass more carefully and respond accordingly if the horse seems agitated, let's keep the roads safe for all road users.
