You can join our Reserve List if you can answer YES to all four questions: - Are you aged 75 or over? - Did you receive your first booster on or before 14 November 2021? - Are you registered with a GP in Powys? - Could you attend a main vaccination clinic (Builth Wells, Bronllys, Newtown) at short notice? UKRAINE

...Presteigne Area Community Refugee response update: a big thank you to everyone who attended the meeting to discuss the refugee crisis and how we can help as a community. About 70 people attended, around 30 of whom say they are thinking of hosting. A large number have also signed up to offer their practical support (from language teaching to 'buddying' with host households). If you weren't able to attend then here's how you can host if you're interested: you'll need to register both with the UK Homes for Ukraine scheme (https://www.gov.uk/register-interest-homes-ukraine) and with the charity Reset who are working to match people with individuals / families in need and will carry out safeguarding checks (https://www.homesforukraine.org.uk/). The Welsh Government will be able to access information filed on both portals and will also take into account the impact on local communities - schools,

...from Debs, Norton Speedwatch. Thank you for the volunteers that came to the training with Dyfed Powys Police force yesterday afternoon. Road safety has always been very top of my list for personal reasons and a concern I hear on a regular basis is the speed of traffic through the village of Norton & beyond. If you have concerns, would like to keep our communities road safe & can spend a little time doing so as part of our local speed watch group. Please contact myself & I will pass your contact number on to Dyfed Powys Police ...the Dyfed-Powys Rural crime team report that they are starting to to see an increase in calls of livestock worrving. This time of year ewes and lambs are being turned out in to the fields and are an easy target for escaped and unsupervised dogs. If you are walking your dog in the countryside: Do not allow your dog to enter a field on its own, and keep it under your control at all times. Keep your dog on a lead when crossing through fields that contain livestock. Stick to public rights of way. Ideally we would recommend avoiding entering fields containing livestock, even if a public footpath runs through the field. When at home: Make sure you know where your dog is at all times. Ensure that your property is secure and that your dog cannot escape (day or night). If you know your dog has previously chased or attacked livestock, then take responsible measures to prevent it happening again.

We've now launched soft plastic collection points in all of our stores so you can recycle those hard-to-recycle soft plastics - like confectionery wrappers, pet food pouches and wraps like the ones you find on your grape punnets. Look out for a large trolley on wheels at the front of your store to collect your materials. You can drop your used batteries and ink cartridges in our cardboard bins at the front of the store as well.
