Thank you Helen! ...drop off your old unwanted spectacles at Wild Card Tattoos in Presteigne High Street, and Sal will take them to the collection point in Leominster for recycling/re-use.

...Mid Powys GPs ask you to plan ahead for the Queens Jubilee weekend because there will be a four-day holiday weekend with reduced access to GP and pharmacy services.
