...be aware, scammers are cloning 01544 numbers (any numbers!) to make it look as though their calls are both local and legitimate. Even if it appears to be a local number, be vigilant and never give out any personal information unless you're 100% certain of the caller's identity. If you do receive a scam call, from a 'local' number, the authorities want to know about it. Please call Action Fraud on 0300 123 2040'

...from Which! Phoney BT direct debit email. BT is being impersonated by scammers in an email that asks you to change your direct debit details. As fraudulent emails go, this is a convincing one. It includes BT's branding, logo and even BT's customer service phone number. But the link behind the button directs you to a fake website. If you receive a message out of the blue about payment details, please always check with your provider directly before you click. See what the email looks like and what to do if you receive one.

There's nothing to worry about. With the Welsh Government, we are doing some anonymous random sampling of our rubbish and recycling to understand how residents are using the kerbside collection service and if any recyclable materials are still being thrown away with our rubbish instead of being placed in the recycling boxes - PLUS - here in Powys, we no longer send any waste to landfill! All our non-recyclable rubbish is sent to an energy from waste facility where it is used to generate electricity for the National Grid.
