...from Helen - the response from residents to the newly-introduced recycling bins for medicine blister packs at The Old School has been brilliant, filling an almost unbelievable two 480 litre wheelie bins every month BUT we have run into a problem and at present have no way of getting rid of the collected recycling. With the withdrawal of Superdrug from the general collection scheme, specialist recycler Terracycle has had to restrict collection to medical facilities (hospitals, medical centres etc). We are trying to find a solution and will keep you informed but shortly we will have to withdraw the collection bins from The Old School recycling shelter, and ask you to store your blister packs at home if at all possible.

...be warned - we're told that Powys CC have started removing (permanently) the glass and paper recycling bins from community Bring Sites - it might be this month or the next for the Presteigne Bring Site - so if you go and the bins are not there, please do not leave glass or paper at the Bring Site - instead please use your kerbside recycling collection.

...[ed.] Defibrillator for The Old School. If you are a member of the MidCounties Co-Op please take five minutes to enter this Draw to obtain a defibrillator for The Old School/Youth Centre in Hereford Street. It will only take 5 minutes of your time. If successful we would install the defib externally so it's available not only to Old School users, but to the wider Presteigne community and visitors, supplementing the existing defibs in Broad Street and at the Day Centre. SCAM ALERT (from Which? and others)

...Blackmail and sextortion emails have spiked in recent weeks with people receiving emails threatening to expose personal information about them if money isn't transferred. Scammers typically claim they've hacked your device and then detail your personal information, such as your usernames and passwords, threatening to expose your data unless you transfer money to them. If you receive an email like this, don't panic. That's exactly what the scammers want and it's likely nothing will come of it. But here's what you can do if you receive one and how to check if your email address or password has been compromised.

...Fake energy refund emails are back and doing the rounds. With the recent energy price cap announcement, please be cautious of any energy emails appearing in your inbox. Find out how to spot a scam energy rebate email.

An autumn booster of the #COVID19 vaccine will be offered to the following groups to extend their protection against getting seriously ill: residents and staff in older adult care homes - frontline health and social care workers - everyone aged 50 and over - people aged 5 to 49 in a clinical risk group, including pregnant women - household contacts of immunosuppressed people aged 5 to 49 - unpaid carers aged 16 to 49.
