If you have to travel for a supermarket shop then please note:

...update from our Leisure Centre. Following on from the Government announcement and our own confirmation that our centres are now closed, some members have been in touch asking for more information on the options we have in place to make sure you are not financially disadvantaged as a result. We have suspended all direct debit memberships with immediate effect. You don't need to take any action for this to happen, we have organised this for you and no further payments will be taken until such time as we are open. If you have paid up-front for an annual or fixed term membership, your membership end date will be extended ensuring you receive your full membership term when the centre re-opens. However, we are a registered charity so without the income we receive from you there is a risk to the service and the community in the long term and permanent closures of leisure centres across the country can't be ruled out. We are asking, if you can afford it, to consider continuing with your membership subscription during this period for as long as you can so we may continue to operate our centres well into the future and help everyone to live healthy lives. Although our centres are now closed our staff are working tirelessly to support our customers and the wider community to deal with the inevitable questions and queries. We have been able to support other charities like ourselves by donating food and milk from our cafés to local hospitals and food banks to help others less fortunate and who need our help in these unprecedented set of circumstances.
