...Powys County Council launches cost of living information hub with advice and support about dealing with the cost of living. PCC has worked closely with local partner organisations to pull together

a wide range of information in one place to ensure people know what help is already available and how to access it. The online hub at <u>www.powys.gov.uk/costofliving</u> has been created to offer as much advice as possible to those in Powys who may need it during this time. The hub has also been divided into sections for ease of access to information including Household energy advice, Health and wellbeing, Money, benefits and debt advice , Powys foodbanks, Support with your household utility bills, Support for businesses , Support for families with children. Each section has useful information, guidance and advice that may help with a cost of living related problem. Phone numbers and webpage links to other services across Powys and the UK that may be able to help should you need more information on a specific issue are also available. The council is also creating a network of warm spaces across Powys. These are places that can offer Powys people a warm welcome this winter and a chance to socialise, work or take part in activities whilst keeping warm. Details of these spaces will be added to the online cost-of-living hub shortly.

...information from the Town Clerk's Newsletter following the October TC meeting: There was a short talk from a Radnorshire Wildlife Trust representative on a current grant project and the suggestion to plant a hedge along the edge of the Wilson Terrace Play Area.

Local Development Plan Update: The invitation to landowners and developers to put forward candidate sites for development was expected to go out to the public in November.

Warm Spaces Information: Thanks to a grant obtained by East Radnor Care there will be a warm space set up at the Day Centre. The County Council has launched a dedicated web page with information and advice - <u>www.powys.gov.uk/costofliving</u>

Town Wifi Update: Inc parking sensor project: it was hoped that the units to go on the Assembly Rooms would be installed shortly. The project would then be complete. The free wifi is currently available in the majority of the town centre and Hereford Street Car Park and the range will be extended by these extra units.

Annual Report 2021-22: now available - copy in the Library and on the town website.

Lugg Bridge Update: It was noted that the emergency repairs promised by Natural Resources Wales had still not been done. Cllr. Baynham had meetings with the Emergency Planning Section at PCC and will request an update, also advice on the need to remove the white goods at the property urgently before they fell into the river causing additional pollution.

Tree Hub Update: A hub will be sited behind the Old School on Hereford Street for households to collect their free tree. A number of varieties will be available, opening times Wednesdays 4pm to 6pm, Saturdays 10am to 12pm. Open from 19th Nov to 15th December.

...from Oxfam. You can donate your old mobile phones through Fonebank or to any standard Oxfam shop. Turning a mobile phone donation into cash for Oxfam is easy. All data will be wiped on any phone we put up for sale, and the safety of the charger tested. Any phones that can't be sold will be sent to be completely dismantled/recycled through our partner CTR, which also generates income for Oxfam. You can: Donate online through Fonebank or Recycle at any Oxfam shop. Find your local Oxfam shop

...from Kate - you can also recycle mobiles and tablets at Currys in Hereford. They take all and any phones and tablets and recycle. It's OK to take a bundle of them at once. The money made apparently goes to a water charity.....not sure what proportion it is and it's not mentioned in the parts of the website I've seen. Be sure to take cables and plugs off.

...Powys Recycles. Currently, the biggest barrier to recycling in Wales is confusion about what can and can't be recycled. Drinking glasses can't be recycled using the same process used for common glass bottles and jars, which means they can't be collected to be recycled together. Make sure that broken glass is wrapped up safely before putting it in your bag or bin for non-recyclable waste. Alternatively, broken glass can be recycled with 'rubble' at most local recycling centres. Any drinking glasses you no longer want but are in a good condition, donate them to your local charity shop.
