Powys County Council's lead Administration of Liberal Democrats & Labour party members, in conjunction with Freedom Leisure, have announced they will close East Radnor Leisure Centre from the 23rd December 2022 to 31st March 2023 - when a decision will be made about its future. The proposal will see the building mothballed and no use will be permitted to anyone, not even schools. The impact, not only on Presteigne but to the wider community will be devastating to both young and old alike. Many people from the wider community, and our local schools use the facilities for soft play, swimming, fitness classes, gym, sports hall incl. karate lessons, junior netball, squash league, football groups and much much more, the list is endless and the impact not only on our physical wellbeing but also our mental wellbeing will be devastating. We must not allow this travesty to happen. The Leisure Centre opened in 1987 after a huge campaign and fund raising by the local community. If you haven't already done so, please go to change.org to sign the Petition, and forward it to friends and neighbours. ...beware of this Post Office redelivery scam text which encourages you to take action by telling you that your parcel has been sent back to your local branch. It sends you to a legitimate-looking website under the guise of charging you for redelivery. This can be very convincing, especially if you're doing a lot more online shopping in the run-up to the festive season. But remember, the Post Office will never contact you like this.
