SCAM WARNING (from WHICH and other sources)

- ...Diet pills scam emails try to trick recipients into ordering Figur or Liba pills under the guise of them being a 'Dragons' Den' success story. The message claims that these diet pills are a 'miracle' and that women lose an average of one-and-a-half stone in a month by using Figur pills, without changing their diet or lifestyle. And at the bottom of the email, you're asked to click a button to 'Go to Figur special offer'. If you click on the link, you'll be taken to another website asking for your personal information. If you enter your details, you'll be giving them to scammers. Don't open report and delete!!
- ...The fake £2 Disney+ subscription. Scammers are using Disney+ branding on dodgy emails that claim recipients can get a 98% discount on subscriptions to the Disney+ streaming service.
- ...Bogus Companies House 'legal action' email. Fraudsters are at it again with impersonation emails, this time impersonating Companies House, the government's companies register, and threatening recipients with legal action. On its website, Companies House states that it will never contact you by email or telephone to ask for secure information about your company.
