- ...update on the big recycling wheeled bins for cartons at the Bring Site these will be removed w/c 3 April BUT Powys now accept the following EMPTY CLEAN containers via the kerbside carton collection, in your RED recycling box; Food and drink cartons Pringles tubes Paper based gravy granule containers with metal ends Paper based hot chocolate/coffee containers with metal ends Other paper based containers with metal ends. Unfortunately PCC cannot at the moment accept paper laminated coffee cups these will need to be disposed of via the wheelie bins at home, or street litter bins for those who are out and about.
- ...Hi-speed Broadband update Broadway Partners the Presteigne & Norton project is progressing as planned. Our survey and design partners will start a full survey of all the Openreach telegraph poles and underground ducts in the Summer. On our current trajectory we are aiming to start our network build in late Summer/ early Autumn. Some news on an update to our most popular package do not worry, the cost has not gone up, but we have increased the speed available to 150 Mbps for £19.99pm

COUNCIL NEWS

...Powys CC - Presteigne road & pavement works: (a) the stretch of High Street pavement between Daphne's and Victoria Fish Bar is being widened permanently (b) a more prominent No-Entry sign is being installed on Hereford Street by the Police Station.

...P&N Town Council has a small grant fund to award a limited number of small grants to local organisations for projects relevant to the Climate Crisis covering matters such as energy use, environmental concerns, the enhancement/protection of biodiversity and the natural environment. Grants are generally for a maximum of £250 if made during the year but larger projects may be considered if submitted by the end of November. ...some items from the recent P&NTC Meetings: Roundabouts: Radnor Hills had agreed to sponsor and maintain the Greenfield Road Roundabout during 2023; a quote for attending to the other roundabout has been received from Caring for God's Acre: Radnorshire Wildlife Trust has indicated a willingness to renew its lease for The Withy Beds on expiry. Dark Skies/Lighting Update: The working group met in early March and the draft application to the International Dark Skies Association was very near to completion. The County Council had seen the proposed lighting policy and is in principle willing to add this to its own lighting policy as an Appendix - this will mean that future developments will need to refer to the policy and should ensure that the lighting continues to conform into the future. Since the meeting calculations on the carbon and financial savings had been carried out and these are estimated as 4.5 tonnes of CO2 reduction per year. 54kw saving per night. 19,710kw per year. If the cost was taken as 0.33p per KwH, it would result in a £6,500 saving per year. The Clerk added that the projected unit cost for the County Council had since been confirmed as 42p per unit, increasing the estimated saving to £8278. Nature Reserve Update: Community Engagement Weekend held and successful. Large number of Trees planted. 150 people had subscribed to a mailing list to be kept informed. Various Photographs of prominent and important local trees taken free of charge by Alex Ramsey. Possible future use to produce a calendar. Future events – tree planting 26th March and pond planting 23rd April. Ponds now filling with water nicely. Possible purchase of two-wheel tractor type machine and various attachments to assist with ongoing maintenance. Agreed subject instead of cut and collect machine subject to lottery approval. Shed adjacent to site available for storage. Clerk to look into insurance costs. Opening Day 3rd June. Tree Hub: 189 trees given out so far in March with one session still to complete. Review of Bus Routes/Stops: Following raised/agreed in meetings with PCC: By pass shelter to be cleaned. Low usage of the Sargeants Bus and problems with connections e.g. to Llandrindod or Hereford. Lack of a direct bus to Llandrindod. Hereford Street stop currently on the wrong side of the road - to be moved. Townend Stop - bus stop markings to be put on road, stop to be marked. Remove old timetable box in Station Road. Timetables to be supplied for Clerk to circulate. Timetable for x11 to be put at bypass shelter. Community Broadband Scheme Update: Broadway Partners is intending to proceed in Presteigne & Norton on a commercial basis, surveying currently planned to start early Autumn

SCAM WARNING (from WHICH and other sources)

...Amazon Prime scam. Scammers are impersonating Amazon to get access to your device - the fraudsters tell consumers that their Amazon Prime subscription is increasing in price or expiring. If you say you want to cancel, you'll be asked to download remote access software such as AnyDesk. This is a genuine program that fraudsters sometimes use to exploit victims. Once you download the program, the scammer will be able to access your device and steal your information or install malware.

...Lego giveaway scam. Fraudsters are using fake Lego branding to offer a £735 Lego set for only £3 in dodgy Facebook posts. To participate in this 'giveaway', victims are asked to play games where they have to choose the right box to 'win'. The fraudsters set time limits to create a sense of urgency and pressure the victim to act quickly. Once the victim has 'won' the prize, the fraudsters ask for their bank details to make a nominal payment – another tactic used to obtain sensitive personal information - enter your details and you hand them to the scammer!!
