...Did you know? Everyone's smart phone is due to sound an alert on 23rd April when the government tests the new UK public warning system. As well as the loud warning ring, a message will appear on the home screen – the alert will sound even if the phone is set to silent. This is a new UK government service that will warn you if there's a life-threatening emergency nearby (this will be a test - you do not need to take any action). In an emergency, your mobile phone or tablet will receive an alert with advice about how to stay safe. The government does not need to know your phone number or location to send you an alert. You may get alerts about: severe flooding, fires, extreme weather. Emergency alerts will only be sent by: the emergency services, government departments, agencies and public bodies that deal with emergencies. In an actual emergency, follow the instructions in the alert to keep yourself and others safe. Visit gov.uk/alerts for information.

It's possible to opt out from the alerts and the test – for example if you have a hidden phone due to risk of domestic violence – by switching off emergency alerts in your phone's settings. More information at https://www.bbc.co.uk/news/uk-politics-65178240

SCAM WARNING (from WHICH and other sources)

...from Powys CC. REPAIRS CALLS TO COUNCIL TENANTS. We have been informed that some tenants are receiving telephone calls from companies saying that they need to do work

to their Council house. Please remember that all of your repairs are carried out by Powys Repairs and their approved contractors. If you receive a telephone call and you are not expecting any repairs to be carried out, please request the company name and a contact number so that you can ring the Housing One Number on 01597 827464 to check. Also, if you receive a visit but you are not expecting any repairs, please ask for an identification card (ID) so that you can ring the Housing One Number to check. Our workmen and contractors will not mind waiting whilst you make a call.

...from Amazon. Protect yourself from scammers. Be careful installing apps or software. Amazon will NOT ask you to install an app or download software in order to receive a refund or to get help from customer service. Never pay over the phone. Amazon will NOT ask you to provide payment information, including gift cards (or "verification cards", as some scammers call them), for products or services over the phone. Always verify orders directly with Amazon. Amazon will NOT call, text, or email you about an order you aren't expecting, and ask you to urgently confirm the purchase. For any question related to an order, always check Your Orders on Amazon.co.uk or via the "Amazon Shopping" app. Be wary of false urgency. Amazon will NOT pressure you to act now. Scammers may try to create a sense of urgency to persuade you to do what they're asking.
