SCAM WARNING (from WHICH and other sources)

...Fraudsters are targeting homebuyers with fake mortgages. Action Fraud has warned about a rise in mortgage scams at a time when rates are soaring. In the past two weeks alone, it has received 538 reports of fake emails from supposed mortgage lenders. The emails claim to offer low-rate mortgages on limited-time deals and include links to check your eligibility or get a personalised rate. However, these links lead to fraudulent websites designed to steal your banking information.

...Scammers impersonate your friends for gift cards. The latest wave of gift card scams involve fraudsters impersonating one of your email contacts and asking you to buy a gift card for them as a favour. This scam begins with a fraudster sending a bogus email posing as someone in your contacts list. They then request gift cards for retailers such as Amazon, claiming that they need help purchasing

the cards for a sick family member. As the message appears to come from someone you know, you might think it's real and agree to buy - be careful, double-check any unusual requests, even if they appear to be genuine at first glance.

... Presteigne Festival - 24-28 August 2023. Presteigne Festival has just completed a project creating and performing songs with 75 children from 5 local schools, including Presteigne Primary. We'd like to thank all involved, especially the staff and teachers. Looking ahead to the end of August, this year's festival features the music of one of the most prophetic voices of the twentieth century, Czech composer Leoš Janáček. In the translation by Nobel prize-winner Seamus Heaney, Janáček's darkly atmospheric The Diary of one who disappeared takes centre stage on opening night. We're very excited to be welcoming Roxanna Panufnik as composer-in-residence, whose music was featured at the Coronation of King Charles III and who was recently described by The Observer as 'a gifted composer with a fast-growing reputation for heart, spunk and individuality ... distinctive in voice, serious, bold and appealing'. Alongside pieces by Bartók, Beethoven, Brahms, Britten, Debussy, Fauré, Poulenc, Rachmaninov and Tchaikovsky, our vital tradition of commissioning and premiering new music continues. New works from Panufnik, Michael Berkeley, Charlotte Bray, Edward Gregson, Thomas Hyde, Sarah Frances Jenkins, Claire Victoria Roberts, Adrian Williams and James B Wilson receive premieres. A world-class artist roster includes the Solem Quartet, Ivana Gavrić (piano), Rachel Roberts (viola), Mathilde Milwidsky (violin), Robert Plane (clarinet), Mark Wilde (tenor), Julien Van Mellaerts (baritone), Zoe Drummond (soprano), Alexei Watkins (horn), Chris Hopkins and Timothy End (piano), the Choir of King's College, London under Joseph Fort and the Festival Orchestra and Chamber Ensemble. We are delighted also to feature actor Christopher Good in our opening night concert. Radnorshire Wildlife Trust is partnering with us to lead two Bees, Bugs and Flowers walks. The first one sold out so quickly that we have just added a second event, also on Friday August 25th. Also included is poetry from Rhiannon Hooson, Christopher Reid on Seamus Heaney, Sioned Davies on The Mabinogion, Gavin Plumley on his book A Home for All Seasons.
