...Pill blister packs - just a reminder that the recycling bin for blister packs at the Old School (Youth Centre) in Hereford Street has been removed. You have two options - to ensure your blister packs are fully recycled by Terracycle under their scheme with Aldi, sign up to receive prepaid postage labels, fill an A4 envelope with blister packs and post it off for free. Simple! For full details and to order your labels, go to https://www.aldi.co.uk/corporate/corporate-responsibility/greener/recycle.
Otherwise, if you're happy for your blister packs to go to an Energy-from-Waste facility, where they will be incinerated and generate electricity for the National Grid, you can now put your blister packs in your wheelie bin (or purple waste sacks). Please DON'T put them in your red kerbside recycling box.

...from Jo - fake email pretending to come from McAfee thanking me for an order I did not make and with a pdf invoice for £532.64 for 5 years antivirus protection - you can't reply to the e-mail and the number to ring to cancel probably (I have not rung it) charges you £50 a minute! Please be aware! ...Which? Black Friday scams - in anticipation of Black Friday, a time when we all hope to find great deals, scammers have been using Facebook to promote fake Currys (and other stores) websites with

attractive but unrealistic offers. If a deal seems too good to be true, it probably is. Go to the Which? website to see examples of these fake websites, so you can avoid falling prey to them.
