COUNCIL NEWS

...from PNTC - Nant Mithil Proposed Wind Farm: Message from developer - "Following our previous emails to you on 20 December 2024 and, to some of you also, 10 January 2025, we've received some correspondence recently requesting a further update. During the statutory consultation period in 2024, we received more than 400 email enquiries and responses, and 138 feedback form submissions. We have reviewed each of these individually. The feedback has helped inform our final planning application. All questions and feedback have been read and considered, and a summary of all issues raised are addressed within a Pre-Application Consultation (PAC) Report. Due to the high volume of feedback received, we are unable to respond to each of you individually. As a reminder, the next stage of consultation for Nant Mithil Energy Park will be managed and led by Planning and Environment Decisions Wales (PEDW), which manages Development of National Significance casework on behalf of the Welsh Government. When PEDW is ready to consult and receive consultation responses on the application, including on the PAC Report, we will update the website, our FAQs and communicate with you to inform you. We will signpost you to the appropriate documentation on the PEDW website, which will host a single version of up-to-date information on the application."

SCAM ALERT

...Which? How scammers can clone your voice. A deepfake phone call is where the caller's voice has been created with or manipulated using artificial intelligence (AI). This is sometimes done through voice cloning, which uses recordings of someone's voice to copy it. Scammers typically use deepfake calls to impersonate family members, companies or government bodies to trick you into paying them. - ...from A F Hughes & Sons, Funeral Directors Headstone Notices in Cemeteries & Churchyards. Many of you are aware that PCC and also Church in Wales have recently been carrying out Health and Safety Checks on headstones fitted in their churchyards and cemeteries. They have marked headstones that are "unsafe" with the following notice or similar. What this means is they are giving notice to the families to get the stones rectified, we are of the understanding that if the stones aren't rectified then they will be lay down in the future due to being "unsafe". The rules and regulations are constantly changing and this is the first time we have come across it being dealt with in this way. For the families what this means is the stones will need to be looked at by a monumental mason to see what work is required, a lot of these stones will most likely need to be drilled out to allow for a Ground Anchor to be fitted to bring the stone up to the current regulations. We realise this may be unexpected and can also understand families frustration as we also have family stones that fall into these categories, we are on hand at the end of the phone if you need us to explain in further detail the way forward. We will need to assess each stone, to enable us to establish the amount of attention it needs going forward to rectify the issue, we will do our very best to keep this as cost effective as possible.
